

1. Identify a power vested in one branch of government, by Article and Section. For example, Article 2, Section 2 gives the Executive branch power to make treaties.
2. Then, identify another branch of government which has a check on that same power. For example, Article 2, Section 2 gives the Legislative branch the power of Consent, such that 2/3 of Senators must agree to the Treaty entered into by the Executive branch.
3. Continuing with my example, explain how the requirement of 2/3 approval by the Senate balances the power between these two branches of government to enter the US into treaties. Explain why this is an important check on the Executive's power to make treaties.
4. Supplement your answer with any relevant information. For example, the current President made campaign promises that he would withdraw from the treaty with Iran if he was elected. However, he has failed to do so two years into his term. The reality is that he cannot do so without 2/3 approval of the Senate....
